	Whistler Olympic Park, the site of the Vancouver 2010 Winter Olympic Games, is located 16 kilometers southwest of Whistler, 50 kilometers north of Squamish and 115 kilometers north of Vancouver in beautiful British Columbia, Canada. LICENSE: No license is required.

**ENTRY**: Skiers must register and pay online on Zone4

Fees increase: December 31, 2022 at midnight prices go up \$10 January 31, 2023 at midnight prices go up \$15 Change Fees: \$10 to January 31, 2023 at midnight, after that \$15 - plus any increase in posted price for category.

#### NO CHANGES ALLOWED after February 22, 2023.

**ENTRY DEADLINE**: February 22, 2023: midnight PST. Absolutely no late entries accepted!

- **BIB PICK UP SAT** Bibs and transponders can be picked up on February 25, 8:00 – 9:30 a.m. in the Technical Building, next to the Stadium area. Bibs will be available for Payak Mini until 12:15. Payak Mini entrants will not be timed.
- **START LISTS**: We recommend that you check the confirmation list for this event to be sure you have registered correctly. Start lists will be available from the Race Office on the day of the event and posted online on Zone4 on Friday, February 24.
- **FOOD / WATER**: For races of 15 km or more, there will be feed stations. Please see course maps. There will be a feed station in the stadium area, as well as on course.
- **CUT-OFF TIME**: All skiers not reaching the 25 km point (stadium lap) in the 50 km event within 2.5 hours (12:30 pm) will not be allowed to continue.
- **RESULTS**: Unofficial results will be posted outside the Race Office after the race. After the event, results will be available to review on Zone4.
- **AWARDS**: Awards will be presented at the venue at the conclusion of the races.
- DRIVING TIMES:Whistler to WOP30 minutesSquamish to WOP60 minutesVancouver to WOP120 minutes

These times are estimates only and may change due to weather and road or traffic conditions. Please allow at least 15 minutes to be processed through the entry gate.
